Fundraising

Carwash - Rainout. Fee was \$50 per cheerleader (which we will be invoiced in August)

Sign up for the brat stand will go out soon. All shifts are filled. If you can't make your shift, YOU are required to find a replacement as this point. We do have car decals for sale. This was going to be part of our carwash sales. They are \$5 each. IF you are interested, let Tausha or Lori Anne know.

Heggies Pizza - 541 pizzas sold. Girls did a great job. We made \$2700 in profit for the individual accounts.

Next sale is mums which will start July 6th and due July 30th. Delivery will be mid-September. More to come via email.

Snap raise - What are people's thoughts. Last year we started with JV, and Varsity did it later. Thought would be to change it so all teams would participate at the same time. This would go to general funds and not individual accounts. This was a very open discussion. Comments were

We lose too much of the profit. Snap keeps 23-30% of sales

Hard to get 100% participation

Required to give too many emails. Tough for smaller families

Go Fund me would be cheaper (we will look into that option)

Lori Anne asked for a raise of hands of who does not want to do snap raise and it was unanimous.

We could look at requiring a sponsorship from everyone and not just Varsity. This is where every cheerleader is required to bring in a \$100 sponsor. Currently this is only required by Varsity. Again if we go this route, the fund would need to go towards a general fund where currently Varsities goes to Nationals.

Jag Jam - This is a dance hosted by the cheerleaders after a football game, located in the cafeteria. It's a few hours of dance. That's it. No concessions, nothing but fun and dancing. We need 12 parent volunteers to help check in kids and check in their items. Kids are not allowed to bring ANYTHING in. No lanyards, bags, waters. Nothing. This is mandatory for all High School cheerleaders. Tickets are like the carwash where we will invoice in August and you keep the funds raised.

Cheer Jam - This is such a great event. It's the first time Jr High and Jr Varsity will cheer. Tanya talked about the need for leads and volunteers. Requirement for all varsity cheerleaders is 2 parents/volunteers for the event. No questions asked. If you do not have 2 volunteers, you will not participate in the funds raised. This is a huge fundraiser for us and volunteers are extremely important. Tanya has a sign up sheets for available lead positions available. All cheerleaders are required to be at this event all day as well as Friday night set up.

Volunteer opportunities - FMSC will be August 16th at the Chanhassen location. We are still in need of parent volunteers. We need 1 adult for every 4 girls under the age of 16. That's a lot of help needed. Tausha will send out a sign up, otherwise please email the board if you are interested in helping.

We are also looking at other ways to help in the community. VEAP offers a food drive where we can pick up bags at their location, drop them off in neighborhoods with a specific pick up date, go back to the neighbors and pick up donations. We are also looking at a backpack - back to school drive. If you have any other suggestion we are open to ideas. Let the board know.

Jag Power - Jag power has started but it's not too late to sign up if you're still interested.

Practice - It's very important to be at practice... and to be on time.

Calendar - The calendar is updated often by Tausha. There is no excuse to miss something because you didn't know.
